The deposition of Thomas Ralph aged about fifty seven years having first taken his oath on the holy evangelist of almighty god that about thirty three years ago Edward Bennet now deceased told him that there stood a markes poplar on a piece of land ground on the lower side of a bank called Whittys branch near the old Wading place was the first bounder of said place. Also said that about eleven or twelve years after James Puffell the above deponent told the now deponent that the said poplar was the bounder of Nehemiah Nicholson and that the said poplar was then marked with sixteen notches and that said notches seemed to have been made a considerable time and further saith not.
