undecided for which the same Littleton demanded his damages by reason of the non performance of the promise and assumption a/s against the a/s John Bishop Ought to recover but because it is not knowne ~~as~~ ^{whether} Justice here what damages the same Littleton has sustained by reason of the non performance of the promise and assumption a/s It is commanded the Sheriff of Somerset County that by the Oath of honest and Lawfull men of his County work had diligently Inquire what damages the same Littleton has sustained as well by occasion of the non performance of the promise and assumption a/s as for his costs and charges by him about his Suit in that part apposed and his Inquisition which thereupon the Sheriff takes he make appear to the Justices of his County Court of Somerset to be held at Widning Creek in the same County the third Tuesday of November then have under his Seal and Hancry of those by whom each the same Inquisition is made he send together with the suit he shall thereof directed and the same day is given to the same Littleton there be — At which said third Tuesday of November to wit the sixteenth day of the same month ~~and~~ ^{Court} One thousand Seven hundred and Ninety Six hundred the said Littleton demand by his attorney a/s and the Sheriff to wit Joseph M'Gester Gent Sheriff of the County a/s demanded certaine Inquisition before him taken at the Court House in his County a/s the fifteenth day of this instant November by the Oath of honest and Lawfull men of his County work by which it appears that the a/s Littleton demanded has sustained damages by reason of the non performance of the promise & and assumption a/s further than his costs and charges by him about his Suit in that part apposed to seven hundred and unity eight pounds of tobacco and for these costs and charges to one pound of tobacco.

Therefore it is considered that the a/s Littleton recovered recover against the a/s John Bishop the damages a/s as by the Inquisition a/s appears also

1002 pounds of tobacco for his costs and charges by him about his Suit in that part apposed to the same Littleton by the Court here at his request of J. M'Gester adjudged while certaine damages in the whole do amount to pounds of tobacco and the a/s.
