was Henry Miles ... should take Henry Miles late of Somerset County planter aforesaid into

Henry Miles of Somerset County in the province of Maryland if he should be  
found in his County and him should safe keep so that he might have his body before the  
Justices of his Lordships County Court of Somerset to be held at Dividing Creek in the same  
County the third Tuesday of August then next to answer unto William Colbourn of apca  
that he tender unto him Two hundred and Seven pounds thirteen Shillings and Two  
pence Current money of Maryland and four hundred and Seventy eight pounds of tobacco  
which to pay he oweth and unjustly detainable and that therefore he should not fail to

All which said third Tuesday of August to wit the seventeenth day of the same month  
and anno Domini One thousand seven hundred and Ninety Six being the day of the returne of  
the said Writt Cometh the said William Colbourn by Francis Allen his attorney and the Sheriff  
of Somerset County to wit Drayg. M'Fester Gent. Likewise came and made returne that by  
Vertue of the writt aforesaid to him whereof directed he had taken the body of the aforesaid Henry Miles whose  
body before the Justices of his Lordships County Court of Somerset at the same day and place in  
the aforesaid mentioned he had knowledge etc.

And the aforesaid Henry Miles by William Buckingham his attorney comes and defend  
the same and injury wherein he and pray leave there of to Impark hereunder next Court and he  
shall it and the same day is given to the aforesaid William Colbourn to

All which said next Court to wit the sixteenth day of November anno Domini One  
thousand seven hundred and Ninety Six same againe as well the aforesaid William Colbourn  
as the aforesaid Henry Miles by their attorneys aforesaid and the aforesaid William Colbourn who offered  
his will aforesaid against the same Henry Miles did not prosecute the same with  
speed etc.

Therefor he and his pledges of prosecuting be in money and lett the  
aforesaid pledges etc and that the aforesaid Henry Miles notwithstanding day also it is considered  
that the aforesaid Henry Miles recover against the aforesaid William Colbourn his damages by reason  
of the premises to Three hundred and Ten pounds of Tobacco to the same Hen-  
ry by discretion of the Justices here at his request for his Posts and Chargers in that part sustained accord-  
ing to the form of the Statute in such case made and provided by the Court here adjudged etc
