Henry Miles of Somerset County in the province of Maryland if he should be found in his bailiwick and him should safe keep so that he might have his body before the Justices of his Lordships County Court of Somerset to be held at Dividing Creek in the same County the third Tuesday of August then next to answer unto William Colbourn of a plea that he tender unto him Two hundred and Seven pounds sixteen Shillings and Two pence current money of Maryland and four hundred and Seventy eight pounds of tobacco which to him he Oweth and unjustly detained &c. and that there of he should not fail &c

All which said third Tuesday of August to wit the seventeenth day of the same month anno. Dom. One thousand seven hundred and thirty Six being the day of the return of the said Writ Cometh the said William Colbourn by Francis Allen his attorney and the Sheriff of Somerset County to wit George McFester Gent. Likewise came and made returne that by virtue of the writ aforesaid to him there of directed he had taken the body of the aforesaid Henry Miles whose body before the Justices of his Lordships County Court of Somerset at the same day and place in that writ aforesaid he had knowledge &c

And the the aforesaid Henry Miles by William Buckingham his attorney comes and defends the force and Injury when &c and prays Leave there of to Imparte hereunto next Court and he hath it and the same day is given to the aforesaid William Colbourn &c

All which said next Court to wit the sixteenth day of November anno. Dom. One thousand seven hundred and thirty Six came againe as well the the aforesaid William Colbourn as the aforesaid Henry Miles by their attorneys aforesaid and the aforesaid William Colbourn who offered his writ aforesaid against the same Henry Miles did not prosecute the same writ with effect &c

Therefore he and his pledges of prosecuting be in money and Lett the self name pledges &c and that the aforesaid Henry Miles without day also it is considered that the aforesaid Henry Miles Recover against the aforesaid William Colbourn his damages by invasion of the premises to Three hundred and Ten pounds of tobacco to the same Henry Miles by discretion of the Judges here at his request for his costs and charges in that part sustained according to the form of the Statute in such case made and provided by the Court here adjudged &c
