against the afft William Bozman by the Twentyeth day of January then next following nor  
prosecutes his writt afft Therefore he and his pledges offrosecuting him money  
and his poft name pledges him and that the afft William Bozman god thereof without day  
also it is considered that the afft William Bozman recover against the afft Thomas Shiles  
his damage by reason of the premises to One hundred and Fifty One

161 pounds of tobacco to the same William Bozman by discretion of the Justices here at his  
request for his Posts and Charges in that part sustained according to the form of the Statute in  
such case lately made and provided by the Court here adjudged etc

Command was given to the Sheriff of Somerset County  
to Thomas Cowington that he should take Thomas Cowington Late of Somerset County  
plaster if he should be found in his Bailywick and him should safe keep so that he might  
have his body before the Justices of his Lordships County Court of Somerset to be held  
at Doding Creek in the same County the third Tuesday of August then next to answer  
unto John Shiles Snd. of pleas of trespass upon his estate and that those of his should
