Wherefore it is considered by the Court here that the said Wm. Dixon pay unto his Lordship the
Lord Proprietary for his fine for and by occasion of the premises aforesaid Twenty Shillings Curr. money
of Maryland &c wherefore the said William Dixon ordered to give security for the payment of the
several Officers fees due by occasion of the premises aforesaid thereupon a certain Stephen
Horsley of Somerset County hath undertaken for the said Wm. Dixon to pay the several Officers
fees due &c

Grace Webb of Somerset County widow came herunto Court in her proper person according
to a certain writ of attachment against her issued for not appearing before the Justice of his Lordship
County Court of Somerset she being Legally Summoned thereto for not burning of tobacco accord-
ing to act of Assembly in such case made and provided and forasmuch as the said Grace Webb
hath nothing to object that was material but was willing to pay her fine for the same &c

Wherefore it is considered by the Court here that the said Grace Webb pay unto his
Lordship the Lord Proprietary for his fine for and by occasion of the premises aforesaid Twenty Shillings
Curr. money of Maryland &c. Littleton Townsend present here in Court undertakes for the
said Grace Webb to pay the several Officers fees due by occasion of the premises aforesaid &c

Cuthbert Ruspole Late of Somerset County planter being summoned to appear at this Court to
answer his not burning tobacco according to Law in such case made and provided &c and for-
as much as the said Cuthbert Ruspole hath not burnt so much tobacco as by Law he was obliged
to burn &c wherefore it is considered by the Court here that the said Cuthbert Ruspole pay unto
his Lordship the Lord Proprietary for his fine for and by occasion of the premises aforesaid Twenty
Shillings Curr. money of Maryland &c. wherefore the said Cuthbert Ruspole ordered to give
security for the payment of the several Officers fees due by means of the premises aforesaid thereupon
a certain Stephen Horsley present here in Court undertakes for the said Cuthbert Ruspole to pay the
