 Q. Daniel Lee } Command was given to the Sheriff of Somerset County that he should take the said Daniel Lee late
 of Somerset County Saddle otherwise called Daniel Lee saddle of the County of if he should be found in
 his bailly writ and him should safekeep so that he might have his body before the Justices of his Lord-
 ships County Court of Somerset to be hold at ^{the third Tuesday of August then next} ~~dividing~~ ^{in the same County} to answer unto his Lordship the
 Lord Proprietary of a plea that he tender unto him Twenty pounds sterling which to the same Lord Proprietary he
 oweth & unjustly detaineth & that thereof he should not fail.

Att which said Third Tuesday of August to wit the seventeenth day of the same month anno. Dom. One-
 thousand Seven hundred and thirty six being the day of the return of the said Writ the said Lord Proprietary
 by William Goldborough his attorney and the Sheriff of Somerset County to wit Joseph M. Barker Gent. & Lewis
 came and made Return that by virtue of the writ aforesaid to him the said directed had taken the body of the said
 Daniel Lee whose body before the Justices of his Lordships County Court of Somerset at the same day and place
 in the writ aforesaid mentioned he had then ready.

Whereupon came herein to Court Thomas Bredie and Avery Morgan both of Somerset County
 planters and undertook and each of them undertook and assumed upon themselves for the same
 Daniel Lee, Likewise the same Daniel Lee present herein Court in his proper person assumed upon
 himself, that if it should happen that the said Lord Proprietari should recover judgment in the plea
 aforesaid against the said Daniel Lee in the said Court or that the same Daniel Lee should be therein convicted
 that then he the said Daniel Lee should pay the cost of the Court thereupon unto the said Lord Propri-
 etary or tender his body in Exemption of such Judgment to the prison of the Sheriff of Somerset ^{County} or his fault
 or thereof or that the said Thomas Bredie and Avery Morgan will do the same for him.

And Whereupon the aforesaid Daniel Lee by George Douglas his attorney Cometh and defendeth the force and
 Injury when & praye for return of the Writ hereunto next Court and he hath it and the same
 day is given to his said Lordship the Lord Proprietary here also.

Att which said next Court to wit the sixteenth day of November anno. Dom. One-
 thousand Seven hundred and thirty six came againe as well the said Lordship the Lord Propri-
 etary as the said Daniel Lee by his attorney aforesaid and whereupon his said Lordship the Lord
 Proprietary by his attorney and Cometh himself herein Court that to wit no further proceed
 against the aforesaid Daniel Lee in the plea aforesaid Therefore the same doeth goe thereof without
 day.
