 seven hundred and thirty six came again aswell the aforesaid Duncan Murray as the aforesaid Richard
 Allison & Eli^s his wife by their attorneys aforesaid and whereupon the same Richard Allison and
 Eli^s his wife pray further Leave thereof to Judge here until next Court and they have it
 and the same day is given to the aforesaid Duncan Murray here also &c

Att which said next Court to witt the eighteenth day of August Anno Domini one thousand
 seven hundred and thirty six came again aswell the aforesaid Duncan Murray as the aforesaid Richard
 Allison & Eli^s his wife by their attorneys aforesaid and whereupon the same Duncan prays that the
 aforesaid Richard and Eli^s his Declaration aforesaid may answer but the same Richard and Eli^s altho' solemnly
 called not but in default nor says nothing in bar or prostration of the action aforesaid of the same Duncan by
 which the same Duncan demands against the said Rich^d and Eli^s the aforesaid - for which Cause the same
 Duncan his Damages by reason of the non performance of the promise & assumption aforesaid against the aforesaid Rich^d
