Pursuant to an act of assembly in this province now in force and in Obediance to the
abovesaid precept was Issued the following attachment against the goods Chattles rights or Credits of
Nathaniel Watson the tenour of which writt followeth in these words vizt

Somerset of Charles absolute Lord and Proprietary of the provinces of Maryland
and Avalon Lord Baron of Baltimore &c. To the Sher of Somerset County
Greeting we Command you that you Attach any of the goods Chattles rights or
Credits of Nathaniel Watson late of Somerset County Merchant if they shall
be found in your bailiwick to the value of thirty pounds Current money and
one thousand pounds of tobacco and when you have the same so attached or
any part thereof the same in your Custody rate keep so that you have the
same before our Justices of our County Court of Somerset to be held at dividing
Creek the third Tuesday of March next then and there to be condemned according
to Act of Assembly to and for the use of a certain Amos Woodward of the City of Annapolis
Merchant unless the said Nathaniel Watson by himself or his Attor-
ney shall appear and answer unto the said Amos Woodward of plea of
traverse upon the cover according to law and that by good and Lawfull men
of your bailiwick you make known unto the person or persons in whose
hands you make the same Attachment that he she or they be and appear
before our Justices of our County Court to be held as aforesaid to show cause if any he she
or they have why the same goods Chattles rights or Credits so attached in his her or
their hands ought not to be condemned and Execution thereof had and made
according to Act of Assembly in such case made and provided if to him her or
them it shall seem meet and how you shall Execute this Witt that you
make ^{known} unto our said Justices at the day and place aforesaid and have you then and
there this Witt Witness Robert King Gent Chief Justice of our said Court the
twenty seventh day of Novemb^r in the thirtieth Year of our Dominion &c
Ann^r Dom One thousand Seven hundred and thirty four

All which said third Tuesday of March to wit the eighteenth day of the same
month Ann^r Dom One thousand seven hundred and thirty four being the
Day
