Therefore the Sheriff is commanded that by the oath of honest and lawfull men of his County which he diligently inquire what damages the same Duncan has sustained by reason of the non performance of the promise & a sum upon his account as for his costs and charges by him about his suit in that part assessed and the Inquisition which thereupon he should take hazard to the damages of his Lordships County Court of Somerset to be held at Bridgwater the third Tuesday of March next under his seal and the seals of those by whose Oath he should take the same & Inquisition together with the wills of his homicide and the same day is granted to the said Duncan time of all the

The Court agreed with Charles Autworth for the keeping Isaac and David Redman aged and finding them good and sufficient meat drink washing Lodging Cloathing and attendance for the ensuing year and he to be allowed for the same next Term Court Eighteen hundred pounds of old Court money of Maryland the -

Ordered that Capt John and I face Hardy to agree with some person or persons to take care and keep a certain Jane Jones an Object and to find and provide for her all necessaries both in meat drink washing Lodging Cloathing and attendance sufficient for such an Object to have & wear yearly and he paid or they to be allowed for her same the

Ordered that John Scarbrough of Somerset County be allowed for the same Eight pounds Court money of Maryland for the keeping and finding a certain Mary Aire an Object sufficient meat drink washing Lodging Cloathing and attendance and all other necessaries meat for such an Object yearly.

Upon the motion of William Buckingham of Council for Mrs Sarah Hale amicably
It is granted by the Court here that George Hale of Somerset County Gent prosecute and sue for and in the behalf of the said Sarah Hale who is within age as her next friend) in all such suits or actions as these shall be occasioned to be brought for her.

Joseph Maffeter of Somerset County hath produced before this Court his Lordships Commission as Sheriff for the County aforesaid which is allowed of and takes the several Oaths appointed by an Assembly to be taken to the Government with the Oath of light Sheriff and Subscribed & Oath of abjuration and test, and executed above according to Law for the due performance of the Office aforesaid with James Martin and John Scarbrough of the County aforesaid Gent his Testy.
