The Court agrees with Charles Actworth for the keeping Isaac and David Redmon of age and finding them good and sufficient meat drink washing Lodging Cloathing and attendance for the ensuing year and he to be allowed for the same Next Levy Court Eighteen ~~and~~ pounds of the Court money of Maryland &c

Ordered that Cap^t John and Isaac Handy to agree with some person or persons to take care and keep a certain Jane Jones an Object and to find and provide for her all such necessaries both in meat drink washing Lodging and Cloathing and attendance sufficient for such an Object to have a year and he she or they to be allowed for the same &c

Ordered that John Scarborough of Somerset Gent. be allowed for the sume eight pound Court money of Maryland ^{per year} for the keeping and finding a certain Martha Aries an Object sufficient meat drink washing Lodging Cloathing and attendance and all other necessaries mete for such an Object per year &c

Upon the motion of William Baskinham of Council for M^r. Sarah Gale Amior &c It is granted by the Court here that George Gale of Somerset County Gent. prosecute and sue for and in behalf of the said Sarah Gale (who is within age as her next friend) in all such suits or actions as there shall be occasion to be brought for her &c

Joseph McEster of Somerset County Gent. pro duce the Crown Court his Lordships Commission as Sheriff for the County aforesaid which is allowed of and takes the several Oaths appointed by act of assembly, to be taken to the Government, with the Oath of light sheri^{ff} and subscribed the Oath of abjuration and test, and bound according to Law for the due performance of the Office aforesaid with James Martin and John Scarborough of the County aforesaid Gent. his Boty.
