in his proper person and undertook and assumed upon himself for the said Henry Wingate
that if it should happen that the said Thomas Watkins should recover Judgment in the plea aforesaid
against the said Henry Wingate in the same Court or that the said Henry Wingate should be
therein convicted that then he the said Henry Wingate should pay the Judgment of the Court thereon
unto the said Thomas Watkins or tender his body in execution of such Judgment to the prison
of the Sheriff of Somerset County in Satisfaction thereof or that he the said John Willey
will do the same for him &c.

And the said Henry Wingate by Robert Jenckins Esq. his attorney Cometh and
defendeth the foresaid Injury when he had pray Leave thereof to Impare hereunto next
Court and he hath it and the same day is given to the said Thomas here also &c.

Att which said next Court to wit the seventeenth day of the same month and year One thousand
Seven hundred and thirty Six came againe as well the said Thomas Watkins as the said Henry
Wingate by their attorney aforesaid and whereupon the same Henry pray further Leave thereof to
Impare hereunto next Court and he hath it and the same day is given to the said Thomas here
also &c.

Att which said next Court to wit the sixteenth day of November and year One
thousand seven hundred and thirty Six came againe as well the said Thomas Watkins as the
said Henry Wingate by their attorney aforesaid and because the said Thomas did not declare against
the said Henry nor prosecute his writ aforesaid

is considered that the said Henry Wingate recover against the said Thomas Watkins his damages by reason
