the better known and Enquired into and we do hereby constitute ordain and appoint Thomas Haywood of
the County of Somerset Gentle to be your Clerk and to make due Entries of your proceedings thereon and
all and do in all things relating to the premises as any other Clerk of such Court hath or ought to doe with
the accustomed profits kind of and further we do appoint John Sheldon of the County of Somerset to be
your Surveyor for this Execution Impowering him to have and receive the same fee profits & perquisites
as any other Surveyor for the said Service whoe for late had In Testimony whereof we have caused.
These our Letters to be made patent Willm G. Embrey and well beloved Samuel Ogle Esqre Lieut
Colonel & Chief Governor of our said province of Maryland this 26th day of October in

Robert King and W^m Stoughton Gent or one of you having taken the said Oaths are hereby
Empowered to administer the same to the Justices and Commissioners respectively as they are
nominated in the within Commission and we will that you having taken the said severall Oaths
do severally subscribe the test and oath of abjuration and for your so doing this shall be your
sufficient warrant and Authority hereoffail not and when you have the same so done you are
to Certifie the same under your hands and seals to us in our High Court of Chancery with
all convenient speed Within our trusty and well beloved Samuell Ogle Esq: Lieutenant-
Gent and Chief Governor of our said Province of Maryland this 26th day of October in the 22nd Year
of our Dominion A. D. Anno Domini 1736
