 the better known and Enquired into and we do hereby constitute ordain and appoint Thomas Maynard of
 the County of Somerset Gent. to be Justice Clerk and to make due Entries of your proceedings therein and
 act and do in all things relating to the premises as any other Clerk of such Court hath or ought to do with
 the accustomed profits thereof and further we do appoint John Sheldon of the County of Somerset to be
 your Crier for this Court Impowering him to have and receive the same for profits & perquisites
 as any other Crier for the Liberties heretofore hath had In Testimony whereof we have caused
 these our Letters to be made patent Witness Our hand and Well beloved Samuel Ogle Esq. Lieute-

 be taken by Act of asembly of this province to the Government as also the oath of Judge or Justice
 to the within mentioned Robert King Esq. Stoughton Gent. and we will that you the said
 Robert King and W^m Stoughton Gent. or one of you having taken the said Oaths are hereby
 Impowered to administer the same to the Justices and Commissioners respectively as they are
 nominated in the within Commission and we will that you having taken the said severall Oaths
 do severally subscribe the test and oath of abjuration and for your doing this shall be your
 sufficient warrant and Authority hereof fail not and when you have the same so done you are
 to Certifie the same under your hands and seals to us in our High Court of Chancery with-
 all convenient speed Witness our trusty and well beloved Samuel Ogle Esq. Lieutenant
 Gen^l and Chief Governour of our said province of Maryland this 26th day of October in the 22nd Year
 of our Dominion &c. Anno Domini 1736
