them respectively shall seeme meete which is by the Court here granted unto him he giving good Security
according to Act of Assembly in such case made and provided &c Whereupon the said John
Follows with Levin Hale Esq: his security both present herein Court in their proper
person acknowledged themselves Indebted unto Lordship the Lord Proprietary of the province
of Maryland &c In the sum of five pounds Current money of said province of their goods
and Chattells Land and tenements jointly and severally to be made and levied to the use
of his said Lordship his heirs and Successors if it happen that the said John Follows do and shall
not pay unto his said Lordship the sum of fifty shillings Current money of Maryland yearly and every
year he shall keep such Ordinary or house of entertainment as aforesaid &c
Likewise the said John Follows and Levin Hale Esq: his security both present herein Court
as aforesaid acknowledged themselves Indebted unto his Lordship the Right Honourable the
Lord Proprietary of the province of Maryland in the sum of forty pounds Current money of
