ordered by the same Court ^{to give} ~~to give~~ ^{to give} recognizance in ten pounds Sterling Cash for their good behaviour
and appearance at June Court next to be hold for the County aforesaid to answer an assault by them
said to be committed

Whereupon the said Cornelius Dickerson and Charles Dickerson
present before the Court as aforesaid acknowledged themselves indebted unto his Lordship the Lord
Proprietary in the sum of ten pounds Sterling Cash, of their goods and Chattels Land, and ten-
ants severally to be made and levied to the use of his said Lordship his heirs and Successors
If it happen that the said Cornelius Dickerson and Charles Dickerson and each of them do
shall not make their personall appearance before the Justices of this Lordship's County Court
of Somerset to be hold in the Court House at Dwidning Creek the third Tuesday of June next
and do not answer unto his said Lordship of and concerning a certain Indictment against
them, for an assault by them said, to be committed, on a certain Joshua Merrile &c. and do
not stay and abide the Judgment of the Court thereon, and do depart the same Court without
leave and in the meantime if they and each of them be not of the good behaviour towards his
his said Lordship and all his good people & more especially towards the said Joshua Merrile &c.
