Whereupon It is ordered by the Court here that the said Wm. Hayman Junr give security for the payment of the severall fines then due upon the Indictment of. Thereupon a certain James Anderson of Somerset County planter present herein Court in his proper person undertook for the said William Hayman and assumed upon himself that he would pay unto the severall Officers then due of fees due by means of the premises of on the Indictment of In case the said William Hayman doth not pay the same &c
