(Likewise the said William Benson assumed upon himself) that if in case the
said James Laws should recover Judgment in the pleas. against the said
William Benson or that the said William Benson should be therein convicted
that then he the said William Benson should pay the Condemnation of the
Court thereupon or tender his body in Execution of such Judgment to the prison
of the Sheriff of Somerset County in Satisfaction thereof or that he the said George
Lanh will do the same for him.

Whereupon the said William Benson in his own proper person cometh and defendeth
the force and Injury wherein &c and saith that he cannot gainsay his action aforesaid of the aforesaid
James Laws nor but that he was in debt to him for the sum of one hundred and twenty pounds
of Maryland in manner and form as the aforesaid James above against him hath declared wherev.
the said James Laws pray Judgment for his debt aforesaid and his costs and damages sustained
by occasion of the detaining of the same debt to him to be adjudged &c

Therefore it is considered by the Court here that the aforesaid James Laws recover
against the said William Benson his debt aforesaid and his costs and damages sustained
by occasion of the detaining of the same debt to him hundred & fifty Pounds

Planter Executor of the Testament of William Horsey
late of the same County deceased if he should be found in his bailiwick and him
should safe keep so that he might have his body before the Justice of his Lordships
County Court of Somerset to be held at Dividing Creek the third Tuesday of March
then next to answer unto Joshua Caldwell late high Sheriff of the same County
of a plea of trespass upon the same &c and that whereof he should not fail &c.

All which said third Tuesday of March to wit the eighteenth day of the same month Being the day
of the return of the same W^t 1735 unto the said Joshua Caldwell by William Buckingham his attorney and
the Sheriff of Somerset County to wit Joseph Mifflin Gent at the same day made return that the aforesaid
John Horsey is not found &c Wherefore as before command is again given to the Sheriff of
Somerset County that he should take the said John Horsey if he so that he might have his body be-
fore the Justice of his Lordships County Court of Somerset to be held at Dividing Creek in the same County
