Whereupon the said Andrew Scott present here in Court in his proper person is by the same Court adjudged to give Special Bail to the action aff^t thereupon afftair — Joseph Maclester late of Somerset County Gentleman came hereinto Court in his proper person and undertook for the said Andrew Scott and assumed upon himself (likewise the said Andrew Scott assumed upon himself) that it in case the said Robert Givan should recover judgment in the plea aforesaid against the said Andrew Scott or that the said Andrew Scott should be therein convicted that then he the said Andrew Scott — should pay the Condemnation of the Court thereupon or rend^t his body in Execution of such Judgment to the prison of the Sheriff of Somerset County in Satisfaction thereof or that he the said Joseph Maclester will do the same for him &c.

Whereupon the aforesaid Andrew Scott by William Bickingham his attorney Cometh and defendeth the force and Injury when &c. and saith that he cannot gainsay the action aff^t of the afo^t Robert Givan nor can he say but that he did assume upon himself in manner & form as the afo^t Robert Givan above against him hath Com^t plainted and as to the damage of the same Robert by him by Occasion of the premises in that part sustained the same Andrew saith and confesseth that the afo^t Robert Givan hath sustained damages by Occasion of the premises beyond his costs and charges by him about his Visit in that part apposed to Two pounds two shillings and two pence Current money of Maryland to one hundred and Ninety eight pounds of Tobacco.
