sums within mentioned in the hands of Esther White Ex^t of the testament
and last will of William White late of the same County dec^d and at the same
time and place made known by Francis Borer and John Doe good and law-
full men of my bailiwick that she should be and appear at the day and place
within contained to show cause as is therein mentioned so answers

And the said Esther White appearing as Ex^t by George Douglas her attorney comes and saith
that he cannot gainway but that the said Ester as the Ex^t of the Ex^t William White hold of
the rights and Credits of the aforesaid Nathaniel Watson to the value of Twenty pounds Curr^t money
nor can he say but that the same ought to be condemned in the hands of the same Esther for the use of
the aforesaid Amos Woodward as of the rights and Credits of the said Nathaniel Watson and not
more Whereupon the said Amos ^{by his attorney Ex^t} prays that the aforesaid twenty pounds Curr^t money so as Ex^t confessed may
be condemned in the hands of the aforesaid Esther as Ex^t of the Ex^t William as of the rights
and Credits of the Ex^t Nathaniel towards satisfying unto the said Amos his damages and all
Costs & Charges accruing by means of the attachment Ex^t - - -
