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the aforesaid Joseph in the aforesaid sum of eighteen pounds four shillings current money to be paid unto the same Joseph when thereof afterwards he should be required. Nevertheless the aforesaid Michael altho often required the aforesaid sum of money unto the aforesaid Joseph hath not paid; but that unto him hitherto to pay altogether hath refused and still doth refuse to the damage of the same Joseph thirty pounds current money and one thousand pounds of tobacco and thereupon he bring suit and doth bring here into Court the writing obligatory of which the debt aforesaid doth testify the date whereof is the same day and year aforesaid
pledges &c Inq Doe & Richard Roe

And the aforesaid Michael Morris by William Buntingham his attorney cometh and defendeth the force and injury whereof and saith that he cannot gain say the action aforesaid of the aforesaid Joseph Smaller nor can he say but that the writing obligatory is the deed of him the same Michael nor but that he oweth the same Joseph the aforesaid eighteen pounds four shillings current money in manner and form as the aforesaid Joseph above against him hath declared. whereupon the same Joseph prays judgment for his debt aforesaid and his costs and damages sustained by reason of the detaining of that same debt by him to be adjudged.

Therefore it is considered by the Court here that the aforesaid Joseph Smaller recover against the aforesaid Michael Morris his debt aforesaid and his costs and damages sustained by reason of the detaining of the same debt to Two hundred and Ninety Nine pounds of Tobacco to the same Joseph of this aforesaid by the Court here adjudged and the aforesaid doth testify in manner as above.
