

1703. Edmond Inninge Esq. } Somerset County s. William Turner late of Somerset County planter others
1704. William Turner -- } : wife called William Turner of Somerset County was summoned to answer
unto Edm. Inninge Esq. of a plea that he render unto him five
thousand pounds of Tobacco which to him he oweth & unjustly detaineth.

And Whereupon the same Edm. Inninge by William Buckingham his attorney saith that
whereas the afd. Wm. Turner the fourth day of September which was in the year of our
Lord God Seventeen hundred and thirty four at Somerset County afd. by his certain writing
obligatory had granted himself to be bound unto the afd. Edm. Inninge in the afd. sum
of five thousand pounds of Tobacco to be paid unto the said Edmond when thereof after
wards he should be required Nevertheless the afd. Wm. Turner altho' often required the
afd. five thousand pounds of Tobacco unto the afd. Edmond hath not paid but that unto
him hitherto to pay altogether hath refused and still doth refuse to the damage of
the same Edmond five thousand pounds of tobacco and thereupon he bringeth the Suit
and doth bring hereinto Court the writing obligatory afd. which the debt afd. in form afd.
doth testify the date whereof is the same day and year afd. before. *Edm. Inninge Esq. Pl. & D. Roe*

And the afd. William Turner by William Goldborough his attorney cometh and defendeth
the force and Injury when s. and saith that he cannot maintain the action afd. of the afd.
Edmond nor can he say but that the writing obligatory afd. is the deed of him the same
William Turner nor but that he oweth the same Edmond the afd. five thousand pounds
of Tobacco in manner and form as the afd. Edmond above against him hath declared
whereupon the afd. Edmond prays Judgment for his debt afd. and his costs and damages
Sustained by Occasion of the detaining of that same debt to him to be adjudged s.

Therefore it is considered by the Court that the afd. Edmond Inninge recover against the
afd. William Turner his debt afd. and his costs and damages Sustained by Occasion of the
detaining of that same debt to Two hundred and Ninety Nine
pounds of Tobacco to the same Edmond by the Court here of his afd. adjudged
and the afd. William in Mercy s.
