and whereupon the said William Jones prayer further leave hereof to Imparte here unto next Court and he hath
it and the same day is given to the aforesaid John Rider here also &c.

All which said next Court to witt the Seventeenth day of June anno domini One thousand seven hundred and
fifty five came againe as well the aforesaid John Rider as the aforesaid William Jones by their attorneys aforesaid
and whereupon the said William Jones as before defendeth free and injury whereto and saith that he
did not affince upon himselfe in manner and forme as he said John above against him hath complained
and of this he putteth himselfe upon his Country and his selfe also.

Upon which it is commanded His Sheriff of Somerset County that immediately he shal come to come here
before the Justices of his Lordships County Court of Somerset now sitting at Doding Creek in the County of
twelve &c by whom &c and who neither &c to recognize &c because as well & and afterward immediately
came the forenamed Jury & the Juror of that same Jury by Joseph M'Fester Gentle Sheriff of the County
aforesaid to this Court panelled being called come to witt Day next William Holland John Waters Thomas Wall
Angels alderman Jonathan Sturges Geo: Brewton James Breman Wm Miller Richard Chambers James Naun
& John Lane who to say the truth of the premises as being duly elected tryed and sworn and from
the Barre of which Court of their Verdit of and upon the premises as to Rider between themselves
to remaine together did come, and afterward to the same Barre for their Verdit in that part
to render did returne whereupon the aforesaid John Rider altho solemnly called came not but made
default nor is his writt aforesaid further presented &c

Therefore it is considered by the Court here that the aforesaid John Rider take nothing by his
will and declaration aforesaid but that he and his pledges of prosecuting to witt John Doe and Rich Rose be
hidoft in Mery and that the aforesaid William Jones go thereof without day &c and further it is considered
that the aforesaid William Jones Recover against the said John Rider five hundred & Sevealy One
