

and whereupon the said William Jones prays further leave thereof to Imparte here until next Court and he hath it and the same day is given to the aforesaid John Rider also &c.

All which said next Court to wit the seventeenth day of June and Dowd one thousand seven hundred & thirty five came againe as well the aforesaid John Rider as the aforesaid William Jones by their attorneys aforesaid and whereupon the said William Jones as before defende the force and injury which he and he hath that he did not assume upon himselfe in manner and form as the said John above against him hath complained and of this he puts himselfe upon the Country and the oaths also.

Thereupon it is Comanded the Sheriffe of Somerset County that Immediately he should cause to come here before the Justice of this Lordships County Court of Somerset now sitting at Diving Brook in the County of twelve &c. by whom &c. and who neither &c. to recognize &c. because as well &c. and afterwards Immediately came theroof the Jury &c. and the Jurors of that same Jury by Joseph M^r Gester Gent. Sheriff of the County aforesaid to this Impanned being called came to wit Day Scoll William Holland John Waters Thomas Wall Angells aldrison Jonathan Singer Geo: Beaton James Brennan Wm. Miller Richard Chambers James Neame & John Lane who to say the truth of the premises and being duly Elected tryed and sworn and from the Bar of which Court, of their Verdict found upon the premises and to Render; between themselves to Commune together did leave, and afterwards to the same Bar for their Verdict in that part to render did return whereupon the aforesaid John Rider altho' solemnly called came not but made Default nor is his writt aforesaid further prosecuted &c.

Therefore it is considered by the Court here that the aforesaid John Rider take nothing by his will and declaration aforesaid but that he and his pledges of prosecuting to wit John Doe and Richd Roe be theroof in merry and that the aforesaid William Jones go theroof without day &c. and further it is considered that the aforesaid William Jones Recover against the said John Rider five hundred & Seventy One --

573 pounds of Tobacco for his Costs and Charges by him about his defence in that part sustained to the said William Jones here according to the form of the Statute in such case lawfully made and provided adjudged and that the aforesaid William Jones have theroof Execution &c.
