And whereupon J. D. Thomas by Francis Allen his attorney complains that whereas he the sd. Thomas the fifteenth day of March Anno Dni One thousand seven hundred & thirty three at the County of Somerset aforesd within the Jurisdiction of this Court was possessed of two hogheads of tobacco weighing Neat One thousand Eighty nine pounds of the Value off ten pounds curr. money of Maryland as of his proper Goods and Chattels and so being of the same possessed the sd. two hds. of tobacco out of his hands & possession casually lost w. sd. two hogheads of tobacco afterwards to witt of aforesd. fifteenth day of March in the year aforesd to the hands & possession of the sd. John by finding came in with the sd. John well knowing the two hogheads of tobacco aforesd. to be of the proper goods & Chattels of the aforesd. Thomas and to him the sd. Thomas of right to belong & appertain but plotting & fraudulently Intending the sd. Thomas of the aforesd. two hogheads of tobacco to defraud & deprive the sd. two hogheads of tobacco to the sd. Thomas altho' the same to do the sd. John by the sd. Thomas was often therunto requested hath not delivered but the same two hds. of Tobacco afterwards to witt on the Sixteenth day of March in y. year aforesd. to his own proper use did convert & dispose to the damage of the sd. Thomas of twenty pound curr. money of Maryland And thereupon he brings suit &c. In. Doe. Al. Re. Whereupon the said John Adelott by George Douglas his attorney cometh and defendeth the force and Injury wherof: and prays leave thereof to Judgment hereuntilt next Court and he hath it and the same day is given to the aforesd. Thomas hereal. &c. Alth. which said next Court to witt the Eighteenth day of March Anno Dni One thousand Seven hundred and thirty four came again as well the aforesd. Thomas Fletcher
