as also Nine hundred and Seven pounds of tobacco to the same Robert Downs at his request for his costs and charges by the Court last of Surtees adjudged and that the afo^r Mathew be taken &c

John Aydelott vs Thomas Fletcher } Somerset County 1795 John Aydelott late of Somerset County planter
P: John Aydelott was attached to answer unto Thomas Fletcher of a sum of tobacco upon the fact
and whereupon of P: S: Thomas by Francis Allen his attorney complains
that whereas he the S: Thomas the fifteenth day of March anno Domini Eighteen hundred and thirty
three at the County of Somerset aforesaid within the jurisdiction of this Court was possessed
of two hogsheads of tobacco weighing neat One thousand Eighty nine pounds of the value
of ten pounds curr^t money of Maryland as of his proper goods and chattels and so being in
the same possessed the S: two hogsheads of tobacco out of his hands & possession casually lost w^t
S: two hogsheads of tobacco afterwards to wit of aforesaid fifteenth day of March in the year
aforesaid to the hands & possession of the S: John by finding same nevertheless the S: John well
knowing the two hogsheads of tobacco aforesaid to be of the proper goods & chattels of the
aforesaid Thomas and to him the S: Thomas of right to belong & appertain but plotting &
fraudulently intending the S: Thomas of the aforesaid two hogsheads of tobacco to defraud &
desire the S: two hogsheads of tobacco to the S: Thomas altho' the same to do the S: John
by the S: Thomas was often thereto requested hath not delivered but the same two
hogsheads of tobacco afterwards to wit on the Sixteenth day of March in y^e year aforesaid to his
own proper use did convert & dispose to the damage of the S: Thomas of twenty
pounds curr^t money of Maryland And thereupon he brings suit v^s C: Jno. Doe A: Pro
Whereupon the said John Aydelott by George Douglas his attorney comitteth and defendeth
eth the force and Injury wher^t: and prays leave thereof to implead hereuntill next
Court and he hath it and the same day is given to the afo^r Thomas to answer
Allt which said next Court to wit the Eighteenth day of March Anno Domini One
thousand eight hundred and thirty four came again as well the afo^r Thomas affe
