to decess and defraud the aforesd^d several Sums of Money & Tobacco to the sd^d —
John altho^{tho} the same to do the sd Benjamin in his life time to witt on the twenty
fifth day of Decemb^r in the year last aforesd^d & often afterwards and the aforesd^d —
Joseph since the decess of the sd Benjamin to witt on the first day of May Anno —
Dom Seventeen hundred & thirty four & often afterwards at the County of Somerset
aforesd^d they were thereunto ^{requested} have not paid or contented nor either of them hath
paid or contented but the same to him hitherto to pay have refused and the sd^d —
Joseph the same to the sd John to pay still doth refuse and deny whereupon the sd^d —
John saith he is woud & hath damage to the value of eight pound eighteen shillings
and money of Maryland and three hundred and thirty four pounds of tobacco —

day of March Anno^m Dom One thousand Seven hundred and thirty four came againe
as well the aforesd^d John Alkison as the aforesd^d Joseph Houston Esq^r of Benjamin Houston by
their attorney aforesd^d and whereupon the said Joseph Houston Esq^r of Benjamin Houston
prayeth further leave thereof to argue hereuntill next Court and he hath it and
the same day is given to the aforesaid John herealso &c.

At the which said next Court to witt the seventeenth day of June Anno^m Dom One thousand seven hundred
and thirty five came againe as well the aforesaid John Alkison as the aforesd^d Joseph Houston Esq^r of
by their attorney aforesd^d and thereupon the said Joseph as before defendeth the force and Injury when &c.
and saith that he cannot deny the action of the aforesd^d John nor can he say but that the said
Benjamin in his life time had a promise upon himself in manner and form as the aforesd^d John above
against him hath complained and as to the damage of the same John by him by occasion of the
premises in that part sustained the same Joseph saith and confesseth that the aforesd^d John hath sustained
