Damages by occasion of the premises beyond his Costs and Charges by him about his Suit in that part appoyed to four pounds nine shillings and four pence three farthings and one hundred and sixty seven pounds of tobacco and not more to be Levied of the goods and Chattels of the said Bayly to be administered on &c. and because the said John Denys not this but the same allegation Confesseth to be true prayer being for those damages above Confessed together with his Costs and Charges of to him to be adjudged &c.

Therefore it is Considered by the Court here that the aforesaid John Alkison Recover against the said Joseph Houston Executor of the same Benjamin Houston his damages aforesaid to the said sum of four pounds nine shillings and four pence three farthings Current money and one hundred and sixty seven pounds of tobacco in form of Confessed as also three hundred & twenty three pounds of tobacco for his Costs and Charges aforesaid to the same John by the Court here and Consent of the parties as adjudged to be Levied of the goods and Chattels which were of the said Benjamin at the time of his death remaining if so much thereof in his hands he hath and if so much in his hands he hath not than the Costs and Charges of to be Levied of the proper goods and Chattels of the said Joseph Houston the said debt in money &c. memorand^m the following amount should have been entered at the foot of the declaration but was omitted & entered as followeth vizt
