Cornelius hath not hitherto paid or in any sort contented altho the same to  
wit the said Thomas afterwards to wit on thirtieth day of August Ann  
Dom<sup>d</sup> Seventeen hundred and thirty two at Somerset County aforesaid and often  
afterwards by the said Cornelius was required; but the same to the said Cornelius  
to pay or in any sort content hath altogether refused and still doth even  
refuse to the damage of the said Cornelius ten pounds current money of  
Maryland and thereof he bringg. Suit &c. — Pledges &c. In<sup>d</sup> Doe & Rec. Rec.

Whereupon the said Thomas Billings to present herein for in his proper person at the prayer  
of the aforesaid Cornelius Kellonk by his attorney aforesaid is adjudged to give special bail to the action aforesaid  
Whereupon a certain John Britt of Somerset County planter present herein for in his proper  
person undertook for the said Thomas Billings and assumed upon himself (Likewise the said  
Thomas Billings present herein for as aforesaid assumed upon himself) that if in case the said  
Cornelius Kellonk should recover judgment in the pleasure against the said Thomas Billings or  
that the said Thomas Billings should be therewith convicted that then he the said Thomas Billings  
should pay the fundamental of the cost whereupon or lende his body in execution of such  
Judgment to the prison of the Sheriff of Somerset County in Satisfaction thereof or that he the  
said John Britt will do his same for him &c.

And the aforesaid Thomas Billings by Francis Allen his attorney comes and defend the same  
and injury whereof and pray <sup>hath</sup> leave to Imparte here unto next Court and he hath it and the  
same day is given to the aforesaid Cornelius how also he —

All which said next Court to wit the seventeenth day of June and Dom<sup>d</sup> One thousand  
Seven hundred and Ninety five came againe in unto the aforesaid Cornelius Kellonk as the aforesaid Thomas Billings  
by their attorney aforesaid and whereupon the said Thomas Billings aforesaid defend the same and —
