taken nothing by his writt and Declaration aforesaid but be in mercy for his false Ramour and that
the said Thomas Billings go thore of without day and further it is Considered by the Court here that
the said Thomas Billings recover against the said Cruelius

his body before the Justices of his Lordships County Court of Somerset to be held
at Diving Creek the third Tuesday of March then next to answer unto Signey
Brown of a plea of trespass upon the Case &c. and that thoreof he should not fail
At which said third Tuesday of March to wit the eighteenth day of the same month
and Days One thousand Seven hundred and thirty four being the day of the return of
of said writt cometh the said Signey Brown by Robert Jonckins Henry his attorney
and the Sheriff of Somerset County to whom the foregoing writt was directed. Likewise
cometh and maketh return thoreof to the Court here endorsed in these words following
Viz: Cepi corpus P Jos: Macclaster Shes.
