Therefore he and his pledges of prosecution be in mercy and Let the plaintiff name of pledge &c and that  
the said John Dean goe thereof without day also it is considered that the said John Dean recover against  
Howard Moses Tilman his damages by occasion of the premises to One hundred - - -

100 - - - pounds of tobacco to the same John Dean by discretion of the Justices here at his request  
for his costs and charges in that part sustained according to the form of the Statute &c by the Court here  
adjudged

At John Atkinson -

Command was given to the Sheriff of Somerset County that he should take  
to the said Thomas Lambden late of Somerset County Merchant ad. dict. ~  
Thomas Lambden of Somerset County in the province of ~  
Maryland Merchant if he should be found in his Gailewick and  
him should safe keep so that he might have his body before the Justice of his Lordship, ~  
County Court of Somerset to be held at Duxbury Creek of third Tuesday of June then next ~  
to answer unto John Atkinson of a plea that he render unto him One hundred & Sixty  
pounds curr. Cash of Maryland which to him he owes and unjustly detains &c

And the aforesaid John Atkinson by Francis Allen his attorney declared against  
the aforesaid Thomas Lambden in the plea aforesaid a following Bill.

Somerset County At Thomas Lambden late of Somerset County Merchant ad dict. ~  
Thomas Lambden of Somerset County in the province of Maryland Merchant was ~  
Summoned to answer unto John Atkinson of a plea that he render unto him One hundred ~  
and Sixty pounds curr. Cash of Maryland which to him he owes and unjustly detains &c ~  
And whereupon the sd John by Francis Allen his attorney saith that whereas the sd  
Thomas the twenty fifth day of August anno domini Seventeen hundred & thirty three ~  
at the County of Somerset aforesd within the first of this Court by his certain writing ~  
obligatory which the sd John with the seal of the sd Thomas signed herein to Court  
biring the date whereof is the same day & year aforesd did acknowledge himself to be ~  
bound unto the sd John in yf. aforesaid One hundred & Sixty pounds to be paid unto  
yf. sd John when he should be thereunto required yest the sd John tho: often requi-  
red the sd Eighty pounds to the sd John hath not rendered but the same to him ~  
hitherto to render hath done & still doth deny and unjustly detain to the damage-  
of the sd John of ten pounds money aforesaid and thereon he brings suit &c
