

Court thereupon or render his body in Execution of such Judgment to the Prison of the Sheriff of Somerset County in Satisfaction thereof or that they the said Charles Ramsey and John Lambson or each of them will do the same for him &c.

Whereupon the said Thomas Lambson by William Borchingham his attorney cometh and defendeth the force and Injury whereof and saith nothing in barr or preclusion of the action aforesaid of the aforesaid John Atkinson by which the same John Remains the against the aforesaid Thomas thereof undefended &c.

Therefore it is Considered by the Court here that the aforesaid John Atkinson recover against the aforesaid Thomas Lambson his debt aforesaid and his damages by Occasion of the detaining of the same debt to four hundred & Twenty five pounds of Tobacco to the same John of his aforesaid by the Court here adjudged and the aforesaid Debt in mercy &c.
