such case made and provided &c. which order was delivered him on the
Joseph Macclister high Sheriff of Somerset County for the same tobacco &c.

Ordered that Capell King of Somerset County gent. have an Order for Eight
pounds of tobacco he bringing in the second best specie of Linnen according to act of assembly.
his said case made and provided &c. which order was delivered him on the
of Somerset County for the same tobacco &c.

Ordered by the Court that John Hunt recover against Isaac Moor sixty pounds of tobacco for
his attendance two days as an evidence on behalf of the said Isaac Moor against William
he having made oath to the same &c.

Ordered by the Court that Charles Dashiell, John Badley Major Floyd and Richard Hoopington
recover against John Shuler thirty pounds of tobacco each for their attendance three days each on behalf
of his Lordship against the said John Shuler they having made oath to the same &c.
