that the aforesaid John Brett recover against the aforesaid Edward Thompson his  
damages aff: to the aff eight pounds Seven shillings and Six pence half pence money  
or also all Costs and Charges by the said John paid out and expended by way of attach-  
ment against the goods chattel Rights or Credits of the aff: Edward Thompson according  
to act of Assembly in such case made and provided &c: —

Ordered by the Court that Mifflin James Martin and William Lane lay out a load from  
Peter Claywells Ind: over Cauckers Creek by Richard Sturges plantation unto the Old road by Christo-  
pher Glafey plantation, the said load to be laid out of the least of prejudice to any person  
or persons whatsoever &c: —

Ordered that George Oliver of Somerset County planter have an Order for One thousand  
pounds of tobacco he bringing in the best piece of Linen according to act of Assembly in  
such case made and provided &c: which order was delivered him on the  
Joseph McFester High Sheriff of Somerset County for the same tobacco &c: —

Ordered that Capell King of Somerset County yeoman have an Order for Eight hundred  
pounds of tobacco he bringing in the second best piece of Linen according to act of Assembly.  
In such case made and provided &c: which order was delivered him on Cap' Dodsley Miffler High Sheriff  
of Somerset County for the same tobacco &c: —

Ordered by the Court that John Hunt Recover against Isaac Moore Sixty pounds of tobacco for  
his attendance two day as an Evidence on behalf of the said Isaac Moore against William Shultz  
he having made oath to the same &c: —

Ordered by the Court that Charles Darville, John Bradley Major Floyd and Richard Hoopngton  
Recover against John Shultz Ninety pounds of tobacco each for their attendance three day, each on behalf  
of his Lordship against the said John Shultz they having made oath to the same &c: —
