All which said next Court to wit the seventeenth day of June Anno Domini one thousand seven hundred and thirty five came againe as well the afo. Duncan Murray as the afo. Wriham Crapper by their attorney &c. and praymunt as the said doth not prosecute his writt aforesaid against the afo. Wriham Crapper Therefore he and his pledges of prosecuting be in mercy and let the afo. name his pledges. and that the afo. Wriham Crapper go thereof without day also it is considered that the afo. Wriham Crapper recover against the afo. Duncan Murray his damages by Custom 16s of the premises afo. to one hundred and sixty four pounds of tobacco to the same Wriham by discretion of the Justice here at his request for his Cook and Charges in that part sustained according to the form of the Statute &c. by the Court here so judged &c.
