Ordered by the Court that Thomas Hearn recover against Joshua Caldwell sixty pounds of tobacco being due unto him for his attendance three days as an Evidence on behalf of the said Joshua Caldwell against Tho. Holbrook he having made oath to the same.

Command was given to the sheriff of Somerset County that he should take Mary Stillee late of Somerset County widow if she should be found in his Bailiwick and her should safe keep so that she might have her body before the Justices of his Lordships County Court of Somerset to be hold at dividing week the third day of November then next to answer unto John Maglaughlin administrator of all and singular the goods and Chattels Rights and Credits which were of Mary Magraw late of the same County dec^d at the time of her death who died intestate as his said of plea of her part upon the case and that thereof he should fail &c

All which said third Tuesday of November to wit the nineteenth day of the same month and Dow. One thousand Seven hundred and thirty four being the day of the Return of the said Writ cometh the s^d John Maglaughlin by William Beekingham Gent. his attorney and the Sheriff of Somerset County to whom the foregoing writ was directed Likewise cometh and maketh return thereof to the Court heretofore in these words following vizt Epi Corpus so answers Joseph M^r Carter shad

And the said Mary Stillee by Francis Allen her attorney cometh and doth set the force and Injury when &c. and prayeth ^{without} leave to Imparle here until next Court and sh^d hath it and the same day is given to the s^d John Maglaughlin adm^r as a^d here also &c

All which said next Court to wit the eighteenth day of March and Dow. One thousand Seven hundred and thirty four came againe as well the s^d John Maglaughlin adm^r as a^d as the s^d Mary Stillee by their attorneys a^d and whereupon the said Mary by her attorney a^d offer herself against the s^d John in the plea a^d but the same John altho' solemnly called comes not to prosecute his writ a^d against the said Mary &c.
