Several goods and Chattels, Lands, and tenements to the use of his said Lordship his heirs & Successors if it happen  
that the said Patrick Kerse do not make his personale appearance before the Justices of his Lordships County  
Court of Somerset to be held at Bridgwater the third Tuesday of November next and doe not answer unto his  
Lordship of and Concerning such things as shall be then & there objected against him on his Lordships behalfe &  
do not stand & abide the Judgment of the Court thereon, and do depart the same Court without leave and in the  
meantime if he is not of the good behaviour towards his said Lordship and all his good people then &

James Mills } James Mills son of James Mills of Somerset County deceased is by the Justices of his own County  
bound to bound out an apprentice according to act of assembly in such case made and provided unto them  
This Wise. Thomas Wise of the said County Cudwanier while he arrives at the age of twenty <sup>one</sup> years he being  
Eighteen years of age this August, the said James Mills the younger to serve his said Master the full term  
and during which term the said James Mills the younger his said Master well and faithfully shall serve his  
master keep his commandments lawfully and honestly every where willingly shall do and in all things as good &  
faithfull apprentice shall demean himself to wards his said Master and all his during his term aforesaid &c.

In consideration of which service the said Thomas Wise present herein Court in his proper person before  
the Justices of Somerset County Court in manner and form following that is to say that he the said Thomas  
Wise during the term aforesaid learn his said apprentice the trade of a Cudwanier and tanner and to lead well in the  
Bible and to write and at the Expiration of his servitude give him anew suit of Cloathes over and above his common  
wearing Cloathes and a sett of Cudwaniers Tools and Likewise provide for his said apprentice meat drink washing  
Dressing and Cleaning mete for him to have & wear during his term aforesaid &c.

Whereupon the said Thomas Wise is ordered to give security for the Complying the Covenants aforesaid &c.

Whereupon the said Thomas Wise with James Martin of Somerset County Gentleman present here in Court  
in their proper persons acknowledged themselves indebted unto the said James Mills the younger in the sum of  
Twenty pounds Sterling each of their several goods and Chattels Lands and tenements to the use of the said James  
Mills the younger his heirs and assigns to be made and Seined &c. If it happen  
that the said Thomas Wise do not during the term aforesaid learn his said apprentice the trade of a Cudwanier and to  
lead well in the Bible and to write and at the Expiration of his servitude do not give him anew suit of Cloathes over &  
above his common wearing Cloathes and a sett of Cudwaniers Tools and Likewise provide for his said apprentice  
meat drink washing Dressing and Cleaning mete for such an apprentice to have & wear during his term aforesaid &c.

Francis Ayres a poor aged infirm person is adjudged by the Court here to be tax free for the future as is  
requested &c.

The Reverend Paul Palmer Dissenting Baptist minister came here into Court in his proper person  
pray that he may be admitted to preach and teach the several congregations that shall come to hear him
