Whereas an order was passed last June Court by the worshipful Justices of Somerset County  
that the Subscribers should view & lay out a road from Peter Claywells Junr. over Caucher <sup>Crack</sup> to the  
old Road by Christopher Glafers old plantation in pursuance to the said order we have viewed  
& laid out the aforesaid road as follows to wit that the road be cleared to pass out of the old County  
road that leads from the ferry towards the sea side about a quarter of a mile above the aforesaid  
Peter Claywell plantation over Caucher Crack by Michael Tarrs old orchard and from thence  
by Richd. Sturges plantation & along from the said plantation to the aforesaid Christopher  
Glafers old plantation with ref. our hands this 21<sup>st</sup> of Aug<sup>r</sup> 1735

according to act of assembly in such case made and provided &c

Other and so continued to be ever since the Neck was reared and your petitioner likely now to be  
deprived of the Liberty of the said Road by some of his Neighbours to his great damage your petiti-  
oner therefore humbly prays that your worship will grant such order as in your wisdom you shall  
think fit that the said Road may be continued as formerly and your petitioner (as in duty bound) shall  
ever pray &c
