One thousand seven hundred and thirty five came the said Sheriff to wit to the Myester Gent to whom the said Subpena was directed and he made return that he had Summoned the said Robt Hodge as by the precept of the said Comanded Likewise came here unto Court as well the said John Fortune as the said Robert Hodge with the Child of the said John and the petition of being againe read and heard and fully understood and the severall allegations as well on behalf of the petitioner as on the part of the said Robert Hodge and what the severall evidences deliver upon both at the Bar in Relation to the premises, all which being by the Court maturely
