And this afforesaid the said Lord Proprietary his Justices of the same County Court and for the same Lord Proprietary doth give the same Justices here to understand and be informed that John Roberts late of Manning hundred in Somerset parish in the County of Gloucestre the nineteenth day of June and Dow. One thousand Seven hundred and thirty four was seised of actions in the same hundred and County and within the Jurisdiction of this Court being and then and there was the chief person and master of the family in the same house then residing and that Daniel Jones Constable of the same hundred duly authorized and qualified the same nineteenth day of June in the year aforesaid did repair in person to the same house and did then and there require of the said John Roberts a true List from under his hand distinctly naming all the taxable persons which he then had within his said family and altho' the same John Roberts then there did give unto the same Daniel Jones a list and amount of sundry Taxable persons in his said family then residing yett to the same John Roberts the Laws of this Province Little weighing or regarding Remhor Roberts a Taxable person in his family then residing in the same List did not write down or mention or cause to be written down or mentioned but the same Remhor Roberts to be a taxable person in his family from the knowledge of the said Daniel Jones then and there did Counsel contrary to the form of the act of assembly - Entituled an act for the appointment of Constables and what relates to their Office and ascertaining what persons are taxable and against ^{the same} the said Lord Proprietary that now is his good rule and Government &c. wherefore the said Attorney of the said Lord Proprietary for the same Lord Proprietary prayeth the advice of the Court here in the premises & that due process of Law in this part against the said John Roberts may be made to answer unto the same Lord Proprietary of and upon the premises &c.

And the afforesaid John Roberts by William Beekingham his attorney Cometh and defendeth the force and Injury when &c. and prays Rebearing of the Information aforesaid and to him it is read &c. which being read and heard ^{the said} John pray Leave thereof to Imparle hereunto next Court and the same day is given to the aforesaid William Goldborough who &c. here also &c.

All which said next Court to witt seventeenth day of June and Dow. One thousand Seven hundred & thirty five ^{William Goldborough who &c. the said} came againe as well the said John Roberts by his attorney aforesaid and the said John Roberts pray further Leave thereof to Imparle hereunto next Court and he hath it and the same day is given to the aforesaid William Goldborough who &c. here also &c.
