there was the chief person and master of the family in the same house then residing -

and that Daniel Jones Constable of the same hundred duly authorized and qualified the
same nineteenth day of June in the year aforesaid did repair in person to his same house and did
then and there require of the said John Roberts at the List from under his hand distinctly naming
all the taxable persons which he then had within his said family and altho' the same John
Roberts then thereto did give unto the same Daniel Jones all t and amount of money -

Taxable persons in his said family then residing yett to the same John Roberts the Laws of
this province little weighing or regarding Rembor Roberts a Taxable person in his family then
residing in the same List did not write down or mention or cause to be written down or mentioned
but the same Rembor Roberts to be a taxable person in his family from the knowledge of the
said Daniel Jones then and thereto did Convey contrary to the form of the act of Assembly -
Entituled an act for the appointment of Constables and what relates to their Office and after-
taining what persons are taxables and against ^{the price} of the said Lord Proprietary that now is
his good rule and Government &c wherfore the said Attorney of the said Lord Proprietary
for the same Lord Proprietary prayeth the advice of the Justices in the premises
that due process of Law in this part against the said John Roberts may be made han-
suer unto the same Lord Proprietary of and upon the premises &c

And the aforesaid John Roberts by William Beckingham his attorney Cometh and defend-
eth his free and injury wherein he and prayeth ^{not} concerning of his Information of and to him it
is read he which being read and heard John pray leave hereof to Imparle heremdale next Court
and the same day is given to the aforesaid William Goldborough who he here also &c

All which said Neat Court to witt seventeenth day of August anno Domini One thousand
seven hundred & Ninety five ^{William Goldborough who he here also} came againe as before the said John Roberts by his attorney aforesaid
and the said John Roberts pray further leave hereof to Imparle here under next Court
and he hath it and the same day is given to the aforesaid William Goldborough who he here also
