The deposition of Mr. Thomas Dashiel Ver. aged Sixty nine years or thereabout being sworn on the holy Evangelist of almighty God saith that as he was riding to his brother George Dashiel who lived at Quantico he saw a red oak newly markt and some short time after he and his brother James Dashiel had some talk about that tree and this deponent saith that his brother James Dashiel told him it was his second bounder of a tract of land called anything and this deponent declarereth to the best of his knowledge that this is the very oak which oak stands about a quarter of a mile of the main road that leads from Wicomico Ferry to Nanticoke Ferry on the right hand of a small path that goes along a ridge where Dan. Sheridan formerly lived and further this deponent saith not We the subscribers two of the commissioners in the Commission above mentioned did meet on the abovesaid land called anything we being first qualified according to law and having sumoned and sworn the within witness took his deposition as within specified In Testimony whereof we have hereunto affixed our hands and seals as by the Commission within were required
