The deposition of Mr. Thomas Dashiell Ver. aged Sixty nine years or there about being Sworn on the holy Evangelist of Almighty God saith that as he was riding to his brother George Dashiell who lived at Quantico he saw a Red Oak newly marked and some short time after he and his brother James Dashiell had some talk about that tree and this depon: ant saith that his brother James Dashiell told him it was his second boulder of a tract of land called anything and this deponant declares to the best of his knowledg that this is the very oak (which oak stands about a quarter of a mile of the main road that leads from Wicomico ferry to Nanticoke ferry on the right hand of a small path that goes along a ridge where Dan. Sheridan formerly lived) and further this deponant saith not.
