Therefore it is Considered by the Court here that the afo^d Joseph Maccarter recover against the aforesaid Richard Mitchell his debt aforesaid and his damages sustained by occasion 223 of the detaining of the same debt to three hundred & twenty one - - - pounds of tobacco to the same Joseph of his agent by the Court here adjudged and the afo^d Richard in mercy &c

W^m Day Scott v. Thomas Upton late of Somerset County labourer otherwise called Thomas Upton of Somerset County labourer was R^m. Thomas Upton Summoned to answer unto Day Scott of Somerset County planter of a plea that he render unto him the sum of fifteen pounds in paper money which unto him he owe^t and unjustly detaineth &c And whereupon the same day by W^m Goldsbrough his attorney saith that whereas the afo^d Thomas the thirtieth day of July in the year of our Lord God One thousand seven hundred and thirty five at Somerset County afo^d by his certain writing obligatorie had granted himself to be bound unto the afo^d Day in the afo^d sum of fifteen pounds in paper money to be paid unto the same day when thereof afterward he should be required Nevertheless the afo^d Thomas altho^r often required the afo^d fifteen pounds in paper Money unto the afo^d Day hath not paid, but that unto him hitherto to pay altho^r he hath refused and still doth refuse to the damage of the same day thirty pounds like money and one thousand pounds of tobacco and therefore bringeth the afo^d and doth bring hereto Court the writing obligatorie afo^d which the debt afo^d is in form afo^d testifies, the date whereof is the same day and year afo^d Bladgs w^m Ind. doct R^m Noe

Whereupon the said Thomas Upton by Robert Jenkinson Henry his attorney cometh and defendeth the same and injury where &c and saith that he cannot gainsay the action afo^d of the afo^d Day Scott nor can he say but that the writing obligatorie afo^d is in fact & ^{him} the same Thomas Upton nor can he say but that he owes the afo^d Day Scott the afo^d fifteen pounds in paper money in manner and form as the afo^d Day Scott above against him hath declared wherefore the same day prays judgment for his debt afo^d and his damages sustained by occasion of the detaining of the same debt to him to be adjudged &c

Therefore it is Considered by the Court here that the afo^d Day Scott recover against the aforesaid Thomas Upton his debt aforesaid and his damages sustained by occasion of the detaining of the same debt to two hundred & twenty one 271 pounds of tobacco to the same Day of his agent by the Court here adjudged and the afo^d Thomas in mercy &c
