him the same William Robinson nor can he say but that he owes the afd. Joseph  
M. Clater the afd. One thousand three hundred and twenty pounds of Tobacco in manner  
and form as the afd. Joseph M. Clater above against him hath declared wherefore the  
same Joseph prays Judgment for his debt afd. and his damages sustained by Occasion of  
the detaining of the same debt to him to be adjudged &c.  
Therefore it is considered by the Court here that the afd. Joseph M. Clater recover against  
the afd. William Robinson his debt afd. and his damages sustained by Occasion of  
the detaining of the same debt to. Two hundred pounds  
of Tobacco to the same Joseph of his afd. of the Court here adjudged and the afd. William
