And whereupon the same Edmond Jennings by Robert Jenckins Henry his attorney saith that whereas the aforesaid William Bozman the twenty fifth day of June in y^e year of our Lord One thousand Seven hundred thirty and three at Somerset County aforesaid within y^e Jurisdiction of the Court by his certain writing obligatory did acknowledge himself to be held and firmly bound unto the same Edmond Jennings in y^e sum of five thousand pounds of tobacco to be paid to y^e same Edmond when he should be thereunto requested Nevertheless y^e aforesaid William Bozman altho' after thereunto requested the aforesaid five thousand pounds of tobacco unto the same Edmond he hath not as yet rendered but trespassed to him hitherto to render hath refused and still doth refuse and deny wherefore he saith that he is the word and hath damages to the value of two thousand pounds of tobacco and thereof he brings the Suit &c. and brings the hereinto Court the writing aforesaid which the debt aforesaid in form aforesaid doth testify whose date is the same day and year aforesaid &c.

Whereupon the said William Bozman by George Douglas his attorney cometh and defendeth the force and Injury when &c. and saith that he cannot gain say the action aforesaid of the aforesaid Edmond Jennings nor can he say but that the writing obligatory aforesaid is the deed of him, the same William Bozman nor can he say but that he owe the aforesaid Edmond Jennings the aforesaid five thousand pounds of tobacco in manner and form as the aforesaid Edmond Jennings above against him hath declared wherefore the same Edmond prays Judgment for his debt aforesaid and his damages sustained by Occasion of the detaining of the same debt to him to be adjudged &c.
