and still doth refuse and being where fore he saith that he is in the world and hath
damages to the value of two thousand pounds of tobacco and thereof bringeth the Suit &c.
and bringeth hereinto Court the writing aforesaid whick the debt aforesaid is from
aforesaid doth testify whord date is the same day and year aforesaid &c.

Whereupon the said John Bozman by George Douglas his attorney comitteth and
defendeth the said John Bozman for the said Injury which he did saith that he cannot gainsay the action
affid of the aforesaid Edmond Jennings nor can he say but that the writing obligatory
affid is the deed of him the same John Bozman nor can he say but that he owe
the aforesaid Edmond Jennings the aforesaid Seven hundred pounds of tobacco in
manner and forme as the aforesaid Edmond Jennings above against him hath declared
wherefore the same Edmond prays Judgment for his debt affid and his damages
sustained by Occasion of the detaining of the same debt to him to be adjudged &c.
Therefore it is considered by the Court here that the aforesaid Edmond Jennings
Recordor against the aforesaid John Bozman his debt affid and his damages sustained
by Occasion of the detaining of the same debt to one hundred and Ninety Nine
pounds of tobacco to the same Edmond of his aforesaid by the Court here
adjudged and the aforesaid John in mercy &c.

William Housay to answer unto Joshua Caldwell late high Sheriff of

the same County of a plea of trespass upon the land &c.
And Whereupon the same Joshua Caldwell by Wm Bellingham his
attorney saith that whereas the said William Housay in his life time on the
first day of January in the year of our Lord Seven hundred & thirty three
at Somerset County was indebted unto the said Joshua in the sum of two
thousand Nine hundred and two pounds of tobacco being for the like quantity
of tobacco by the aforesaid Joshua Caldwell for the use and service of the said William
Housay thre before that time at his especial instance and request laid out
and expended as by an account thereof herewith into Court brought may appear
and so thereof being indebted the same William Housay in his life time after
wards to wit the same day and year last mentioned at Somerset County in
consideration thereof upon sum due did assume and to the same Joshua Caldwell
there and there faithfully did promise that he the same William Housay the same
two thousand Nine hundred and two pounds of tobacco to the same Joshua
Caldwell when thereof afterwards he should be required well and truly would
pay
