and sworn upon their Oath do say that the said Benjamin Venable is guilty of the premises as in  
manner and form as the said James Givans above against him hath complained and shewed his damages  
of the same James by him by reason of the premises aforesaid beyond his costs and charges by him about  
his suit in that part apposed to three pounds fifteen shillings curr. money of Maryland for those costs  
and charges to one pound of tobacco.

Therefore it is considered by the Court here that the said James Givan recover against the  
said Benjamin Venable his damages aforesaid by the Jurors aforesaid in sum aforesaid apposed as also  
703. Seven hundred and eight pounds of tobacco for his costs and charges aforesaid to  
the same James Givan by the Court here of his aforesaid increase adjudged whole certain damages in the  
whole do amount to three pounds fifteen shillings curr. money of Maryland and Seven hundred & nine  
pounds of tobacco and the aforesaid Benjamin Venable in mer-  
it of

John Hendry. Writ was given to the Sheriff of Somerset County that he should take the  
afft. Geo: Howard. George Howard late of Somerset County planter if he should be found in his bailewick  
and him should safe keep so that he might have his body before the Justices of the Lord-  
ships County Court of Somerset to be held at dividing Creek in the County as the third Tuesday of  
March then next to answer unto John Hendry of a plea of trespass upon the said afft. and that  
whereof he should not fail. -

All which said third Tuesday of March to wit the Eighteenth day of  
the same month and year One thousand seven hundred and thirty five being the day of the return  
of the said writ sent the said John Hendry by Geo: Douglas his attorney and the Sheriff of Somerset by  
to whom the foregoing writ was directed Likewise concurring withal return there of endorsed by Capi-  
bus prope Manchester Sheriff
