Command was given to the Sheriff of Somerset County that he should take Michael Morris late of Somerset County in the province of Maryland planter otherwise called Michael Morris of Somerset County in the province of Maryland if he should be found in his Bailwick and him should safe keep so that he might have his body before the Justices of his Lordships County Court of Somerset to be held at dividing Creek the third Tuesday of August then next to satisfy Joseph Small of the same province and Dorchester County as well as certain debt of Eighteen pounds four shillings Curr money which the same Joseph in the same Court before the Justices thereof at dividing Creek recovered against him as of two hundred and fifty nine pounds of tobacco which to the same Joseph in the same Court were adjudged for his damages which he had by occasion of the detention of that same debt whereof the same Michael Morris is Convict &c.

All which said third Tuesday of August to wit the nineteenth day of the same month and day One thousand seven hundred & thirty five being the day of the return of the same Writ Cometh. the said Joseph Small by his attorney att. and the Sheriff of Somerset County to wit Joseph McCarter Gent. and makes Return that he had taken the said Michael Morris and him detained in Custody to satisfy the said Joseph his debt and damages att. as by the precept aforesaid he was commanded &c.

Command was given to the Sher. of Somerset County that he should take Bartholomew Baynon late of Somerset County planter otherwise called Bartholomew Baynon if he should be found in his Bailwick and him should safe keep so that he might have his body before the Justices of his Lordships County Court of Somerset to be held at dividing Creek the third Tuesday of August then next to satisfy John Ailworth as well as certain debt of Six hundred and eighty four pounds of tobacco which the same John in the same Court before the Justice thereof at dividing Creek recovered against him as of three hundred and Six pounds of tobacco which to the same John in the same Court were adjudged for his damages which he had by occasion of the detention of that same debt whereof the same Bartholomew Baynon is Convict &c.

All which said third Tuesday of August to wit the nineteenth day of the same month and day One thousand seven hundred & thirty five being the day of the return of the same writ cometh to the said John Ailworth by his attorney att. and the Sheriff of Somerset County to wit Joseph McCarter Gent. and makes return thereof to the Court here enclosed in these words following viz.
