The Condition of the above obligation is such that whereas the Com<sup>rs</sup> of the Gen<sup>l</sup> hath transmitted unto this Court the account of the Estate of Cap<sup>t</sup> John King dec<sup>d</sup> wherein it is found there is due to the above Orphan the sum of one hundred thirty six pounds fourteen Shilling & ten pence half penny if therefore the above Whittington King his heirs Ex<sup>or</sup> Adm<sup>r</sup> assigns or any or either his heirs Ex<sup>or</sup> or Adm<sup>r</sup> do and shall well and truly pay or cause to be paid unto the a<sup>d</sup> Orphan the a<sup>d</sup> sum of one hundred thirty six pounds fourteen Shilling & ten pence half penny according to dec<sup>d</sup> will and act of assembly when the said John King shall arrive at full age to receive the same. Then the above obligation to be void and of none effect otherwise to remain in full force and vertue &c.
